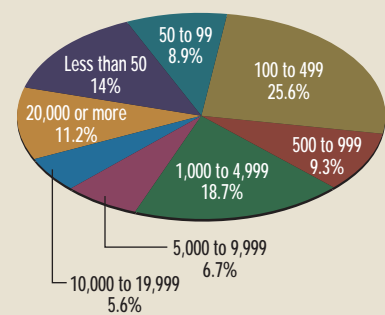


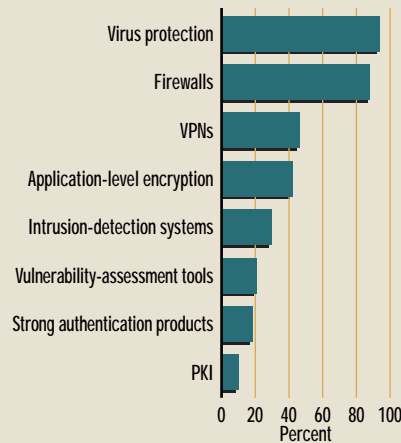

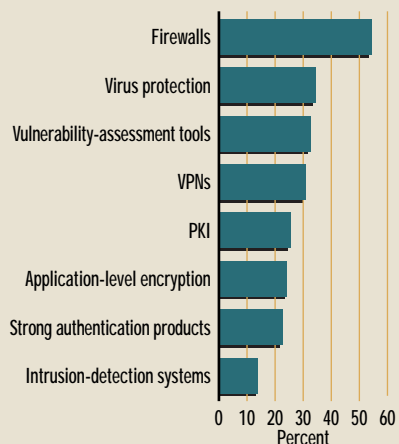
Which network and Internet security products has your organization deployed?



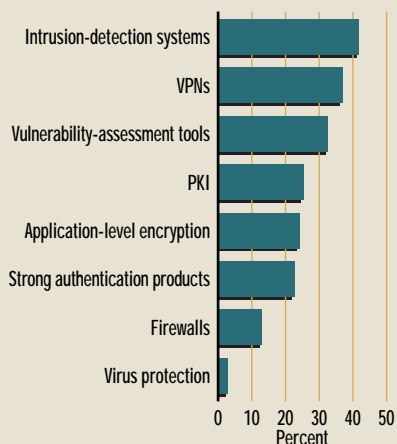
What percent of your IT budget is allocated for your deployed network and Internet security products?



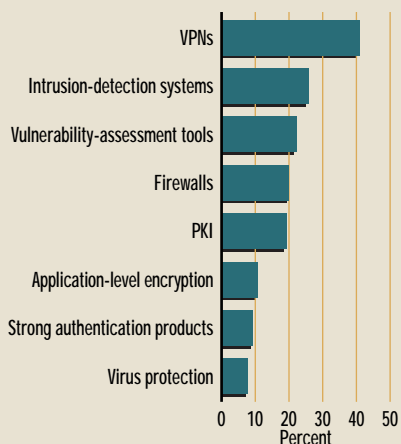
Which product areas do you outsource?



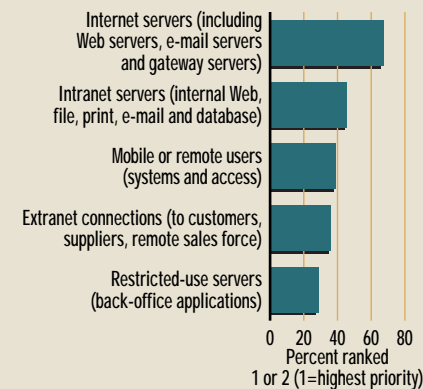
Which of these do you plan to deploy in the next 12 months?



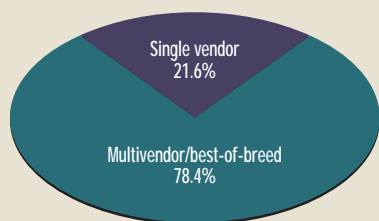
Which services do you plan to outsource in the next 12 months?



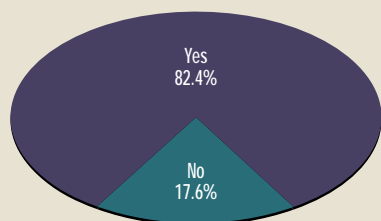
Rank the following security solutions in terms of deployment priority



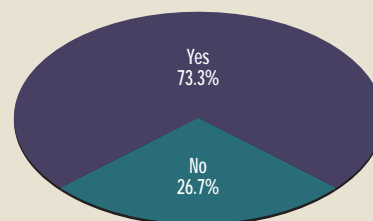
Does your security approach more closely resemble a multivendor/best-of-breed approach or a single-vendor approach?



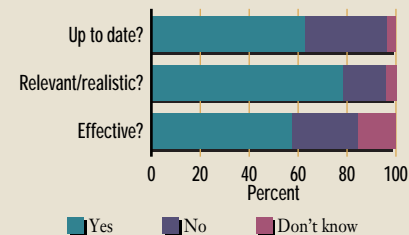
Is your current approach to security (multivendor/best-of-breed or single-vendor) the most preferred one?



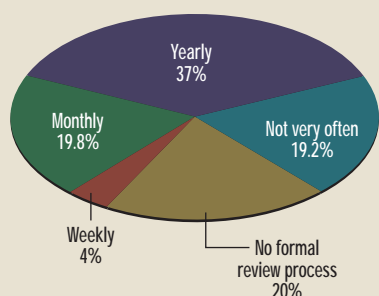

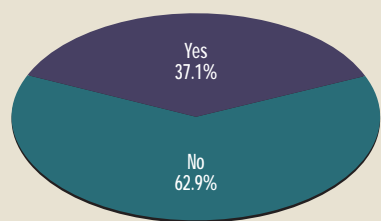

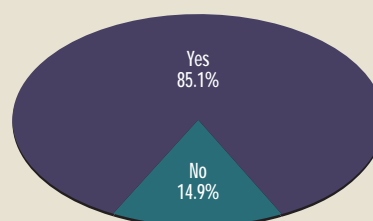
How often do you review/update your policies?
